2. Promote fair play on the pitch, touchline and in the clubhouse and encourage positive support in all aspects of the sport.
3. Develop an appropriate working relationship with participants, members and other positions. Encourage a positive environment by gaining trust, respect and support.
4. Make sure all activities and operations are organised safely and appropriately.
5. Display and encourage high standards of behaviour during all club activities and operations both at home and away.
6. Ensure that all necessary qualifications/training is updated on a regular basis.
7. Abide by RFU guidelines and follow the rules of the club's constitution.
8. Report incidents that could damage the reputation of the club by contacting the Club Chairman and/or relevant committee positions.
