Parents/Carers Code of Conduct

2. Support other players within the team in a positive manner, offering support and assistance at all times and where necessary pointing them in the right direction.
3. Encourage your child to learn the laws of the game (RFU) and the rules within BERFC.
4. Show good practice by supporting training sessions and matches and recognising fair play and applauding all performances.
5. Treat all officials within the game with respect and never argue with their decisions. Positive feedback and questioning is encouraged within BERFC along with attendance at seminars devised to assist parents/supporters in this matter.
6. Show good practice in the management of your child and never force them to undertake actions they are against. Never punish them and always support their decision making ability whatever the result.
7. Use correct and proper language at all times.
8. If in doubt of any circumstances, please report it to the appropriate person within the club. The welfare of players and members is paramount.
